Assemblymember Rodriguez Presents State Budget Allocation Check Totaling \$3.2 Million for the Historical Society of Pomona Valley

(Pomona, CA) – Today, Assemblymember Freddie Rodriguez (D – Pomona) presented a check for a funding allocation he championed on behalf of the Historical Society of Pomona Valley. This funding totals \$3.2 million to preserve Pomona's historical footprint.

The Phillips Mansion has stood strong in the city for 117 years and is now in need of repairs. A portion of this funding will go toward these repairs, and the other portion will benefit the Ebell Museum. These are both landmarks of the city and part of the history that the Historical Society of Pomona Valley works tirelessly to protect.

Pomona Valley has a remarkable history, and having a dedicated membership that works to preserve it is unique. The Historical Society of Pomona Valley works to protect important historic sites, records, and artifacts in the city.
