## **Legislative Update: Senate Appropriations Committee Approves Seven Bills Authored by Emergency Management Chair Rodriguez**

**(Sacramento, CA)** – Today, the Senate Appropriations Committee approved seven pieces of legislation authored by Assemblymember Freddie Rodriguez (D – Pomona). At this point in the process, Assemblymember Rodriguez has advanced nine bills to the Senate Floor that will be voted on before the end of the legislative session. Governor Newsom has already signed two pieces of legislation from the Assemblymember’s 2023 legislative package.

“I am proud to see my legislative priorities obtain further approval in the State Senate. As Chair of the Emergency Management Committee and a career first responder, I am dedicated to improving preparedness efforts for all Californians. This year’s legislative package works toward that goal,” **stated Assemblymember Rodriguez.**
